

## UK Full-Immersion Course

Our UK course combines General English and JFLT training to ensure you are able to develop your exam techniques and overall English level in order to communicate more effectively in various situations:

- Optimize your English Language for use in your day-to-day work environment.
- Build confidence in your communication skills when travelling abroad.
- Communicate effectively when deployed on international missions.

### General English

During the morning you will work with a coursebook, enabling you to improve the four main skills – speaking, listening, reading and writing. You will also work on other key areas to help develop and consolidate your language knowledge. Pronunciation, grammar, vocabulary and idioms are studied extensively in this class. Speaking and listening lessons are an extra opportunity for fluency practice and include a functional application of the language you learn, this is utilised through role playing, debating, pair work, group work and general communication tasks.

### JFLT Intensive

This course will prepare you for the JFLT by improving your exam techniques and developing the language skills specifically required for the exam and when using English in your work environment. You will also develop your military vocabulary range, spoken fluency and accuracy of English when used in a military context. We use a variety of materials, including: military coursebooks, Cambridge exam practice, authentic materials from the UN, NATO, the US and UK military, newspapers/magazines and videos, as well as JFLT practice tests, all in preparation for the exam.

At the end of the course you will receive a certificate confirming your level in accordance with the CEFR (Common European Framework of Reference for languages) and completion of the JFLT training, plus a comprehensive report of your progress. Your final level assessment will prove to be a good indication of your potential JFLT level.

# JFLT Skills Development

As with all examinations, your language skills and techniques will be honed and consolidated for successful implementation in your work and JFLT completion. Skills development includes:

## Reading

Reading for gist, reading for main ideas, reading for detail. Skimming text, understanding logical argument, recognising writers' opinions, attitudes and purpose.

## Writing

Produce effective, well-structured writing with the appropriate use of register; formal VS informal language. Focus on writing academic essays, articles, reports, proposals, presentations, emails, letters and memos. You will learn how to best utilize the English language for expressing opinions, hypothesizing, persuading, comparing and describing as well as justifying arguments and making recommendations.

## Listening

Understanding main ideas and detailed factual information. Understanding the opinions and attitudes of speakers. Understanding the purpose of an utterance and following the development of ideas.

## Speaking

Improve your ability to communicate effectively and diplomatically. Focus on linking ideas, developing arguments, and debating including: giving your opinion, agreeing and disagreeing, conducting meetings and negotiations, making recommendations, giving speeches and presentations.




### **JFLT Grammar and writing skills**
